Garrett currently serves as Branch and former Section Chief for the U.S. General Services Administration/Federal Acquisition Service/Assisted Acquisition Services Division in the Southeast Sunbelt Region. Prior to his assignment as a Section Chief, Garrett worked for GSA in the Federal Acquisition Service as a Senior Contracting Officer for four years in the Warner Robins branch, Atlanta metropolitan area branch, and the Huntsville, AL, branch. Garrett also supported the Electronic Warfare and Avionics branch and Armaments branch within the Aerospace Sustainment Directorate at Robins AFB. While at the NSF, Garrett supported the Science Resources Statistics Directorate and the U.S. Antarctic Program.
