Re: Remote Learning Plan

Southington Local Schools is shifting to remote learning at least until January 3, 2021. This is being done in accordance with recommendations from the Trumbull County Health Department. On Tuesday, November 24, 2020, the Trumbull County Board of Health issued a health advisory recommending all public schools within Trumbull County transition to remote learning through the end of the 2020 calendar year.

**What does this mean for my student?**

**\*The shift to remote learning impacts all K – 12 students within our school district who have been attending in-person instruction.**

**\*We will maintain constant communication with you concerning our plans.**

**\*All athletics and activities will be suspended through at least December 22, 2020, at which point our league and district will reassess.**

**Meal pick-up/delivery?**

**\*Beginning Wednesday, December 2, 2020, we will begin packing breakfasts/lunches for students. As organized this past summer pick-up will be in the back of the building from 10:00 a.m. to noon.**
